Subject: ADVISORY HEATWAVE FOR KARACHI.

I am directed to enclose herewith a copy of Advisory issued by Cabinet Secretariat (Aviation Division), Pakistan Meteorological Department, Government of Pakistan on 17.05.2018 on the subject cited above; stating therein that *"Day temperatures are likely to remain 40-43°C during next 5 to 6 days in Karachi, keeping in view ongoing Ramadan days and people fasting, the Authorities have to ensure adequate supply of power and water so that situation may not aggravate for public"*. The following precautionary measures are advised to be taken:

- a. Monitor the weather advisories of PMD regularly to cope with significant weather conditions during summer season and take required actions.
- b. Provincial Health Department to be on alert.
- c. Heatstroke Centers to be established at all major hospitals / rural health units and private hospitals.
- d. Related emergency medicines to be readily available.
- e. Enhanced and proactive coordination with emergency ambulance services operating in Karachi city, other urban centers and rural areas.
- f. Establishment of helpline to facilitate timely response.
- g. Awareness campaign to be run on electronic and print media to educate populace in heatstroke mitigation measures.

2. It is, therefore, requested to kindly take appropriate necessary action accordingly, under intimation to this Authority.
