Yesterday, Syed Qaim Ali Shah, Chief Minister Sindh held a detailed meeting at DC office Sukkur with the functionaries of line departments, local district administrations and DG PDMA.

The Chairman NDMA, Maj. Gen. Muhammad Saeed Aleem also visited Sukkur today. DG PDMA briefed Chairman about preparedness measure which have been put in place by PDMA Sindh and DDMA's.
