#### SUBJECT: - MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY.

The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued Daily Weather Report on 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2015 at 1000 PST and *BULLETIN No. A-B 047/15*, dated 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2015 (11:00 hours PST), portions relevant to Sindh Province are reproduced here under:

### **Synoptic Situation:**

Seasonal low lies over northwest of Balochistan. Yesterday's well marked low pressure lies over north Rajasthan (India)has weaken into low pressure and now located over south Punjab and its adjoining areas. Under the influence of this low pressure, monsoon currents are penetrating in central parts of the country. Some deflected monsoon currents are already penetrating along the Himalaya into Kashmir and adjoining areas.

## **Weather Outlook for next 24 Hrs:**

Isolated rain-thundershower is expected in Sukkur and Larkana divisions.
