SITUATION UPDATE

- The relief activities in the drought hit districts of Tharparkar continue since last more than 11 days. The relief activities have been expanded to district Umerkot, Sanghar and Khairpur also.
- Till-to-date, 20,117 persons in Tharparkar, 7743 in Umerkot, 6224 persons in Sanghar and 3184 persons in Khairpur have been treated in various fixed and mobile hospitals.
- 2,286,711 cattlehead in Tharparkar, 128,752 in Umerkot, 27,415 cattelhead in Sanghar and 41656 in Khairpur have been treated/vaccinated till to-date.
- 01 female died in Tharparkar today, according to the report of concerned Deputy Commissioner.
- PDMA Sindh has dispatched 2000 family ration bags to drought affected district of Umerkot on 17.03.2014.
- Till to date, 174,940 families have been provided 50 kg wheat bags in Tharparkar.
- 3 trucks carrying 1728 Bags of Atta, 50kg Rice & 50kg Sugar, 4215 Bottles of Mineral Water, 140kg Cooking Oil, 1763 Mixed Ration Packets, 11 Packets of mixed medicines, 509 Packets of Juice, Milk, Milk Powder and Biscuits, collected through Relief Collection Camp at Karachi have reached at drought hit areas of Sanghar
- PDMA Sindh have also provided 10 large size tents to Health Department for establishment of 50 Bedded Tent Hospital at district Umerkot
- Sindh Industrial Trading Estate (SITE) has also dispatched relief goods to Sanghar. They contain 276 bags of 5kg Flour, 98 bags of 5kg rice, 100 bags of 2kg Daal, 60 bags of 50kg wheat and 480 ltr of 1.5 ltr mineral water bottles
- PDMA Camp Office at Mithi and PEOC at Head Office Karachi are functional round the clock.
