SITUATION UPDATE

- The relief activities in the drought hit districts of Tharparkar continue since last more than 13 days. The relief activities in Sanghar, Umerkot and Khairpur districts are also in full swing.
- Today, the Chief Minister Sindh presided a Cabinet meeting at CM House where relief activities in the drought affected districts were reviewed. The CM Sindh directed Cabinet members and administrative departments to ensure that the drought affectees are taken utmost care of in all aspects.
- Till-to-date, 29,716 persons in Tharparkar, 1130 in Umerkot, 6889 persons in Sanghar and 3184 persons in Khairpur have been treated in various fixed and mobile hospitals.
- 2,390,798 cattlehead in Tharparkar, 138,144 in Umerkot, 33,346 cattelhead in Sanghar and 41,656 in Khairpur have been treated/vaccinated till to-date.
- 03 female and 02 children died in Tharparkar whereas 01 male and 02 children died in Umerkot today, according to the report of concerned Deputy Commissioners.
- The Government of Sindh has allocated an additional 22,870 wheat bags of 100 kg and placed at the disposal of DC Tharparkar for continuation of wheat distribution. Till to date, 177,106 families have been provided 50kg wheat bags in Tharparkar.
- Today, PDMA Sindh has dispatched 1000 ration bags to Tharparkar district.
- PDMA Camp Office at Mithi and PEOC at Head Office Karachi are functional round the clock.
