SUBJECT: - MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY.

The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued Daily Weather Report on Monday, 29th July, 2015 at 1000 PST and *BULLETIN No. A-B 045/15*, dated 29th July, 2015 (11:10 hours PST), portions relevant to Sindh Province are reproduced here under:

Synoptic Situation:

Well marked low pressure lies over Rajasthan (India) under the influence of this low pressure, monsoon currents are continuously penetrating into Pakistan. Seasonal low lies over northwest of Balochistan.

Weather Outlook for next 24 Hrs:

Widespread rain-thundershower is expected in Sukkur and Mirpurkhas divisions, while at scattered rain thundershower in Shaheed Benazirabad, Larkana, and Hyderabad divisions. Isolated heavy falls is expected in Sukkur and Mirpurkhas divisions.

Weather Warning:

Isolated heavy falls are also expected in Sukkur and Mirpurkhas divisions during next 24 to 36 Hours. Heavy rains may generate flash flooding and urban flooding in Upper Sindh during the period, and therefore, all concerned authorities are requested to take precautionary measures accordingly.

- 3. The necessary measures taken by District Disaster Management Authorities in accordance to their District Disaster Management Plans/mandates may kindly be communicated to PDMA Sindh via return fax on **021-99251463**.
- 4. The Deputy Commissioners are further requested to keep close liaison with the line departments. It is further pointed out that there is expectation of heavy downpour over Koh-e-Suleiman range which may generate flash flooding in the districts of kashmore, Jacobabad, Kamber Shahdadkot and Dadu. Accordingly, the concerned Deputy Commissioners and concerned Authorities are requested to take requisite precautionary steps.
