Subject: **TROPICAL CYCLONE ALERT (NO. 2)**

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to state that Pakistan Metrological Department issued Tropical Cyclone Alert, that the Depression over southeast Arabian Sea having intensified into a deep Depression moved nearly northwards and lay centered at 0300 UTC, the 2nd June near Latitude 15.2N and Longitude 71.2E, at a distance of about 1150km southeast of Karachi. The system is likely to consolidate into a Tropical Cyclone by late today, keep moving towards North and then re-curve to Northeast towards South Gujarat coast, India. Currently none of Pakistan coastal area is under threat from this system. Fishermen are advised to remain careful.

However, it is requested to kindly take necessary precautionary measures to avoid any loss of life or property, under intimation to this Authority, please.
