HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing below Low flood level.


METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- Yesterday's Well Marked Monsoon low over Northwest Madhya Pradesh moved West-Northwestwards and today lies over Southern parts of Rajasthan and Neighborhood.
- Weak Seasonal Low lies over West Balochistan
- Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating lower half of the country upto 7000 feet, while weak moist currents are also penetrating upper half of the country upto 5000 feet

WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Malakand, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Bahawalpur & DG Khan, Divisions and Shaheed Benazirabad, Dadu, Sukkur & Larkana Districts. Scattered wind-thundershower/rain with isolated heavy falls is expected over Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tharparkar, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot & Sanghar Districts along with East Balochistan.

- Keeping in view above it is therefore requested to please take necessary precautionary measures to avert damages to life & property.

SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing below Low flood level. Mild flows are expected in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a) Yesterday's Well Marked Monsoon low over Northwest Madhya Pradesh moved West-Northwestwards and today lies over Southern parts of Rajasthan and Neighborhood.
- b) Yesterday's trough of Westerly wave over Northern Parts of Iran today lies over Northeastern parts of Iran and adjoining areas.
- c) Weak Seasonal Low lies over West Balochistan.
- d) Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating lower half of the country upto 7000 feet, while weak moist currents are also penetrating upper half of the country upto 5000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Malakand, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Bahawalpur & DG Khan, Divisions and Shaheed Benazirabad, Dadu, Sukkur & Larkana Districts. Scattered wind-thundershower/rain with isolated heavy falls is expected over Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tharparker, Mirpurkhas, Umar Kot & Sanghar Districts along with East Balochistan.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK:

- Rainfall activity is likely to decrease over lower half of the country after 24-Hours.

Pre Alert: • Rainfall activities is likely to increase significantly over the upper catchments of Rivers Kabul, Jhelum, Chenab, Ravi along with Peshawar, Kohat, Banna, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala & Lahore Divisions and Kashmir after 48-Hours.
