The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) vide flood bulletin No.A-53/20 has issued Weather Advisory on 06th August, 2020 at 11.55 PST that is reproduced here under:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

Heavy downpour may generate urban flooding in Karachi & Hyderabad.

ALERT:

Widespread rain/wind-thundershowers with isolated heavy to very heavy falls are expected in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Tando Allah Yar, Matiyari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Jamshoro, Dadu and Shaheed Benazirabad from 06 th to 08 th August-2020. Scattered rain-thundershowers with isolated heavy falls are also expected in, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Ghotki,

SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Heavy downpour may generate urban flooding in Karachi & Hyderabad and Flash Flooding in the Hill Torrents of Eastern Balochistan and Nullahs/Rivers of Coastal Balochistan on 07th & 08th August-2020.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's Well marked Low over Northwest Bay of Bengal moved rapidly Westwards and today lies over Western Madhya Pradesh.
- b. Yesterday's Cyclonic circulation over South Gujarat persists.
- c. Weak Seasonal Low lies over West Balochistan.
- d. Moderate to strong moist currents from Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal are penetrating Southern parts of the country upto 7000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST:

Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Northeast Balochistan and Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore & DG Khan Divisions during next 24-hours.

ALERT: Widespread rain/wind-thundershowers with isolated heavy to very heavy falls are expected in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Tando Allah Yar, Matiyari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Jamshoro, Dadu and Shaheed Benazirabad from 06th to 08th August-2020. Scattered rain-thundershowers with isolated heavy falls are also expected in Bahawalpur, Rahim yar Khan, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Ghotki, Kalat, Jaffarabad, Jhal Magsi, Khuzdar, Lasbella and Awaran on 07th & 08th August-2020.
