The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) vide flood bulletin No.A-54/20 has issued Weather Advisory on 07th August, 2020 at 10.55 PST that is reproduced here under:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Heavy downpour may generate further urban flooding in Karachi & Hyderabad and Flash Flooding in the Hill Torrents of Eastern Balochistan and Nullahs/Rivers of Coastal Balochistan on 07 th & 08th August-2020.

ALERT:

Widespread rain/wind-thundershowers with isolated heavy to very heavy falls are expected in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Tando Allah Yar, Matiyari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Jamshoro, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad, Awaran, Khuzdar and Lasbela. Scattered rain-thundershowers with isolated heavy falls are also expected in Bahawalpur, Rahim yar Khan, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Ghotki, Kalat, Jaffarabad and Jhal Magsi.

SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Heavy downpour may generate further urban flooding in Karachi & Hyderabad and Flash Flooding in the Hill Torrents of Eastern Balochistan and Nullahs/Rivers of Coastal Balochistan on 07th & 08th August-2020.

II: **METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

a. Yesterday's Well marked Low over Western Madhya Pradesh today lies over Southeast Sindh.

b. Yesterday's Cyclonic circulation over South Gujarat has merged into Well Marked Low.

c. Weak Seasonal Low lies over West Balochistan.

d. Moderate to strong moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating Southern parts of the country upto 7000 feet & Light to Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are also penetrating upper parts of the country upto 4000 feet.

e. A fresh strong trough of Westerly wave lies over Northwest Afghanistan.

III: WEATHER FORECAST:

Scattered thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore & DG

ALERT: Widespread rain/wind-thundershowers with isolated heavy to very heavy falls are expected in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Tando Allah Yar, Matiyari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Jamshoro, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad, Awaran, Khuzdar and Lasbela.

Scattered rain-thundershowers with isolated heavy falls are also expected in Bahawalpur, Rahim yar Khan, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Qambar Shahdad Kot, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Ghotki, Kalat, Jaffarabad and Jhal Magsi.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet spell is likely to decrease over Southern parts of the country and Monsoon activity is likely to increase over upper half of the country.
