SUBJECT: - MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY.

The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued Daily Weather Report on Saturday, 25th July, 2015 at 1000 PST, portions relevant to Sindh Province are reproduced here under:

Synoptic Situation:

Well-marked seasonal low lies over north Balochistan and its adjoining areas. Strong Monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in southern parts of the country that may continue during next 12-18 hrs. Strong monsoon currents are then expected to penetrate in upper parts of the country during Sunday to Tuesday that may interact with westerly wave. Strong monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in southern parts of the country during Monday to Thursday.

Weather Outlook for next 24 Hrs:

Scattered rain-thundershower expected in Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad and Sukkur.

Weather Warning:

Widespread rains with scattered heavy at times very heavy falls expected during Monday to Thursday in Sukkur, Larkana, Karachi, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas. Heavy rains may generate flash flooding and urban flooding in the vulnerable area, and therefore, all concerned authorities are requested to take precautionary measures accordingly.

2. Accordingly, I am directed to request you to ensure that all necessary measures including activation of Rain Emergency Centers / District Emergency Operation Centers of your respective DDMA for effective response mechanism,

wherever required are taken. It may also be ensured that sufficient resources such as dewatering pumps are **deployed at low lying areas.**

3. The necessary measures taken by District Disaster Management Authorities in accordance to their District Disaster Management Plans/mandates may kindly be communicated to PDMA Sindh via return fax on **021-99251463**.

4. The Deputy Commissioners are further requested to keep close liaison with the line departments.
