Family ration bags for Districts Umerkot and Tharparkar

Karachi: On 7th of February, 2019, PDMA Sindh on the directions of Government of Sindh dispatched family ration bags for the pregnant and lactating women of districts Umerkot and Tharparkar to complete the three phases supply of ration bags

which started in November 2018.

Talking about the third phase, more than 80 thousand ration bags were dispatched to the area, out of which around 67 thousand ration bags were dispatched to district Tharparkar and around 14 thousand ration bags

were dispatched to district Umerkot.

PDMA Sindh in coordination with NDMA and other international donor agencies is currently working on the short and long term cross sectoral interventions for mitigating the effects of drought.

First meeting of drought working group

First meeting of working group for coordination between the Government departments and management of UN Organizations regarding drought affected areas of Sindh was held at PDMA head office on 31st of January, 2019. During the meeting, food security measures were deliberated upon in detail.

13th meeting of PDMA Sindh board

The 13th board meeting of Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) Sindh was held at PDMA head office on 7th of February, 2019. Senior Member Board of Revenue Sindh, Muhammad Hussain Syed chaired the meeting.

Supervision of relief operations

On 25th of February, 2019, a tragic incident occurred at Jaffar-e-Tayyar Society in Malir where a residential building collapsed in the early hours. PDMA Sindh in response to the incident, immediately coordinated with KMC urban search and rescue team and FOCUS rescue team of Aga Khan foundation. The entire operations were supervised by Director (Operations) PDMA and all necessary equipment & machines were also provided.

Secretary Rehabilitation Department & DG PDMA visit Mirpurkhas

Secretary Rehabilitation Department Riaz Hussain Soomro & DG PDMA Syed Salman Shah visited Mirpurkhas on 11th of March, 2019 and held a meeting with Commissioner Mirpurkhas Abdul Waheed Shaikh. During Meeting, matters related to upcoming regional project of PDMA were discussed.

Commissioner Mirpurkhas assured his full cooperation to PDMA and agreed to work alongside PDMA in providing relief to the public in general.

Secretary Rehabilitation Department & DG PDMA also visited under construction regional office of PDMA and expressed their satisfaction over the progress of work. During visit to Mirpurkhas, they were accompanied by Deputy Director(F&A) PDMA Zain ul Abideen Ansari and Deputy Director (Technical) PDMA Muhammad Aslam Laghari.

Chief Secretary Sindh presides over a meeting on Rescue 1122 Project

On 14th of March, 2019, a meeting under the Chairmanship of Honorable Chief Secretary Sindh was held to review technical feasibility study of Rescue 1122 Project. DG PDMA Sindh Syed Salman Shah & project consultants briefed about the overall concept and implementation strategy. The Chief Secretary directed PDMA to implement all the components of project i.e. EMS(Emergency Medical Services), fire and rescue services simultaneously. Chief Secretary Sindh also said that Rescue 1122 is aimed at carrying out rapid rescue and relief work both in times of crisis and normal days.

SRP is committed towards completing its project within stipulated time period which will be beneficial for government and public in enhancing their capacity to deal with various disasters.
