5. Weather Warning for Sindh:

27th September, 2021

Met Office informed that strong monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in Sindh from 27th September (Monday) and likely to continue till 02nd October (Saturday). Under the influence of this weather system:

Rain-wind-thundershower with heavy/ very heavy falls is expected in Mirpurkhas,
Tharparker, Umarkot, Sanghar, Thatta, Badin, Karachi, Hyderabad, Tando Allayar,
Tando Muhammad Khan, Matiari, Shaheed Benazirabad and Dadu, from 28th
September (Tuesday) to 02nd October (Saturday) with occasional gaps. Heavy falls
are also expected in Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Dadu and Hyderabad during the period.

• Rain-wind-thundershower is expected at scattered places in Sukkur, Larkana and Jacobabad during 28th September (Tuesday) to 30th September (Thursday)

Rainfall Last 24 Hours:

Weather remained hot and dry over most parts of the province. However Light rainfall occurred in Mirpurkhas division. Chief amount of rainfall is Mirpurkhas 2.0mm.
