SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Moderate Flooding is expected in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division during next 48 hours, while Urban Flooding in Karachi & Hyderabad Divisions is also expected during next 48 hours.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's well marked low pressure area over Kutch & Neighbourhood remained stationary.
- b. A fresh trough of westerly wave lies over Northern parts of Iran.
- c. Weak Seasonal Low lies over North Balochistan.
- d. Moist currents of Moderate intensity from Arabian sea are penetrating Sindh upto 7000 feet and weak moist current over upper parts of the country upto 5000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered to wide spread wind-thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls and one or two very heavy falls is expected over Sindh. Scattered wind-thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over East Balochistan & South Punjab. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Malakand, DI Khan, Bannu, Kohat, Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Guiranwala & Lahore Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Subdued rainfall activity over the upper parts of the country will continue. Scattered to wide spread windthunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with isolated heavy and one or two very heavy falls is expected over Sindh. Scattered wind-thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over East Balochistan & South Punjab.
