Moist currents of Moderate intensity from Arabian sea are penetrating Sindh upto 7000 feet.


**WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

**SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:**

**I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:**

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Mild Flooding is expected in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division and Urban Flooding in Karachi & Hyderabad during next 24-hours.

**II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a. Yesterday's well marked low pressure area over Kutch moved slightly Southwards & today lies over Gulf of Kutch and it is likely to weaken.
- b. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of Iran and today lies over Northern parts of Afghanistan.
- c. Weak Seasonal Low lies over North Balochistan.
- d. Moist currents of Moderate intensity from Arabian sea are penetrating Sindh upto 7000 feet and weak moist currents over upper parts of the country upto 5000 feet.

**III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered wind-thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over Sindh & Makran Coast. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Malakand, Hazara, DI Khan, Bannu, Kohat, Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore & DG Khan Divisions.

**IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:**

Wet spell is likely to decrease over Sindh and Monsoon activity is likely to revive over Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir and North & Northeast Punjab.

- Jhelum: Chakothi=41, Hajira=23, Panjera=16, Bandi Abbaspur=14, Sehrkakota=09, Rawalakot=08, Kotli=06 & Chattar Kallas=Trace.
