HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

River Indus at Kalabagh, Chashma & Guddu is in Medium Flood level, River Indus at Taunsa & Sukkur and River Kabul at Nowshera are in Low Flood Level.

ALERT

River Indus at Guddu is likely to attain High Flood Level during 08th to 09th September-2020 and at Sukkur during 09th to 10th September-2020.

SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

River Indus at Kalabagh, Chashma & Guddu is in Medium Flood level, River Indus at Taunsa & Sukkur a River Kabul at Nowshera are in Low Flood Level.

Alert: ● River Indus at Guddu is likely to attain High Flood Level during 08th to 09th September-2020 and Sukkur during 09th to 10th September-2020.

METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES: II:

- a) Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Kashmir & adjoining area continues to persist and is likely to move away Eastwards during next 24-hours.
- b) Seasonal Low lies over Northeast Balochistan.
- c) Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea & Bay of Bengal are penetrating upper parts of the country up to 5000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind-thunderstorm/rain with one or two heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sahiwal & Bahawalpur Divisions. Isolated wind-thunderstorm/rain is expected over Peshawar, Kohat & DI Khan Divisions.

Rainfall activity is likely to decrease.
