SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday trough of Westerly wave over northern parts of Afghanistan today lies over Northern parts of the country.
- b. A Monsoon low has developed over northwest Bay of Bengal.
- c. Seasonal Low lies over North Balochistan.
- d. Moist currents from Arabian Sea & Bay of Bengal are penetrating upper parts of the country upto 7,000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered thunderstorm/rain with isolated heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Jhelum, Chenab, Ravi & Sutlej along with Bannu, Kohat, DI Khan, Rawalpindi & Guiranwala Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchment of River Indus along with rest of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, South & Southeast Sindh, Northeast Balochistan and Sargodha, Lahore, Faisalabad, Bahawalpur & DG Khan Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet spell is likely to decrease.
