SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are in the state of their normal flows.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

a. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northeastern Iran today lies over Northern parts of Afghanistan.

b. Yesterday's well marked Monsoon low over Jharkhand moved Westwards and today lies over North Chhattisgarh as Monsoon low, it is likely to weaken further.

c. Seasonal Low lies over Northeast Balochistan.

d. Weak Moist currents from Arabian Sea & Bay of Bengal are penetrating upper parts of the country upto 5000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Southeast Sindh, and Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala & Lahore Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Northeast Balochistan and Bannu, Kohat, Di Khan, Sargodha, Bahawalpur & DG Khan Divisions.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet spell is likely to increase over the upper parts of the country.
