Subject: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST

I am directed to refer to Pakistan Meteorological Department Flood Forecasting Division Bulletin No. A73/20, dated 26.08.2020, 11:15 hours (PST), under which following has been forecasted:

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

- River Indus at Guddu is in low flood level, while all the other Major Rivers are flowing below low flood level.
- River Jhelum at Mangla (upstream) is likely to attain Exceptionally High Flood level during next 36 Hours, while River Chenab at Marala, Khanki & Qadirabad is likely to attain High Flood level during next 48 Hours.
- Flows are also likely to increase upto Medium flood level in Nullahs of Rivers Chenab & Ravi and Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division during next 48 Hours


METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a) Yesterday's Well Marked Monsoon low over Southern parts of Rajasthan has merged into seasonal low.
- b) Yesterday's Monsoon low over North Bay of Bengal has become well marked and today lies over Northwest Bay of Bengal.
- c) Yesterday's trough of Westerly wave over Northeast Afghanistan today lies over Northern parts of the country.
- d) Weak Seasonal Low lies over West Balochistan.
- e) Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating upper parts of the country upto 7000 feet.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Wide spread thunderstorm/rain with isolated heavy to very heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Kabul, Jhelum, Chenab & Ravi along with Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, Rawalpindi & Gujranwala Divisions. Scattered thundershower/rain with moderate to heavy falls is expected over the upper catchment of River Indus along with Malakand, DI Khan, DG Khan, Sargodha, Faisalabad & Lahore Divisions and East Balochistan & Upper Sindh. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over the upper Catchment of River Sutlej along with South & Southeastern Sindh and Bahawalpur Division.

2. Keeping in view above it is requested to please take necessary precautionary measures to avert damages to life & property.
