SUBJECT: - RIVER SITUATION & QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST.

The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) vide flood bulletin No.A-55/20 has issued Weather Advisory on 08th August, 2020 at 11.05 PST that is reproduced here under:

METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

Yesterday's well marked Low over Southeast Sindh moved westwards and today lies over South of Ormara in Arabian Sea and is likely to become insignificant during next 24 Hours.

WEATHER FORECAST:

Scattered thunderstorm/rain with Isolated Heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Sindh

SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Heavy downpour may generate Flash Flooding in the Hill Torrents of Eastern Balochistan and Nullahs/Rivers of Coastal Balochistan during next 24 Hours. Sharp peaks up to low flood level in River Jhelum at upstream Mangla and Mild flows in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division are expected during next 03 Days.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's Well marked Low over Southeast Sindh moved Westwards and today lies over South of Ormara in Arabian Sea and is likely to become insignificant during next 24 Hours.
- b. Yesterday's trough of Westerly wave over Northwest Afghanistan today lies over Northern parts of Afghanistan.
- c. Moderate to strong moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating Balochistan upto 7000 feet & Light to Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are also penetrating upper parts of the country upto 4000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST :

Scattered thunderstorm/rain with Isolated Heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Sindh and Malakand, Hazara, Rawalpindi & Gujranwala Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, DI Khan, Sargodha, Lahore, Bahawalpur & DG Khan Divisions.

ALERT: Widespread thunderstorm/rain with isolated heavy to very heavy falls are expected in Balochistan.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet spell is likely to decrease further over Southern parts of the country and Monsoon activity is likely to increase over upper half of the country.
