## SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

#### **HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:**

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Sharp peaks of low to Medium flood level in River Jhelum at upstream Mangla and Mild flows in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division are expected during next 03 Days.

#### II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

a. Yesterday's Well marked Low in Arabian Sea has become Insignificant.

b. Yesterday's trough of Westerly wave over Northern parts of Afghanistan today lies over Northeast Afghanistan & adjoining Pakistan.

c. Seasonal Low lies over Northeast Balochistan.

d. Light to Moderate moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating upper parts of the country upto 5000 feet.

#### III: WEATHER FORECAST:

Scattered thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity with Isolated Heavy falls is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Malakand, Hazara, DI Khan , Makran, Rawalpindi & Gujranawala Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over rest of the Punjab, Balochistan & Khyber Pakhtunkhwa along with South & Southeast Sindh.

### IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK NEXT 48-HOURS:

No significant change.
