FLASH FLOOD ALERT

Subject: POTENTIAL FLASH FLOOD IN DADU, JAMSHORO, HUB DISTRICTS AND KIRTHAR RANGE

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Press Release dated 22th July, 2022, afternoon, that, the latest Meteorological conditions strong monsoon currents affecting upper parts of the country likely to enter Sindh and northeast/east Balochistan from **tonight/tomorrow**.

Under the influence this weather system and possible interaction of moist currents from the North Arabian Sea, widespread rain-wind/thunderstorms with scattered heavy/ very heavy are likely to occur in Dadu, Qambar Shahdadkot and Jamshoro districts of Sindh during 23-26 July and Hub districts of Balochistan and along Kirthar Range during 24-26 July 2022.

Possible Impacts

- The persistent heavy spell may trigger flash flood/hill torrents in local nullas/streams that potentially can affect low-lying areas in Dadu, Jamshoro, Qamber Shahdadkot and Hub districts during 24-26 July.
- Heavy/very rainy spell in Khuzdar, Lasbella, Hub districts and other catchment
 areas would increase water inflow and exert more pressure on the Hub Dam during the
 forecast period.
- Particularly, the vulnerable areas of Drigh, Serai Lund, Tribal Lund, Sajjan Joon Payoon, Kululli Laghari, Rajo Gghado, Guhram Jo Goth, Nagar Dharyo, Baghnel, Haji Khan, Wahi, UC Sawero of Taluka Johi (Dadu district) could be affected due to flooding from Nai Gaj.

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairmen DDMAs and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures including:

- Ensure coordination with all relevant authorities of Balochistan for information sharing about flows of Nullahs in adjoining areas of Balochistan and monitor their water level constantly, due to which flash flooding may occur in the adjoining districts of Sindh.
- Coordinate with all authorities to ensure smooth flow of storm water drains in Urban areas.
- Ensure early warning mechanism for evacuation of vulnerable population in areas/districts in case of flash flooding.
- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure provision of water and necessary emergency medicines to the general public during emergency.

- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Emergency Services / Fire Brigades to remain alert for possible fire incidents and ensure preventive measures against fires due to electrification, where possible.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

FOR GENERAL PUBLIC

- Move to safe places in case of any risk of Flash Flooding.
- Monitor the weather updates and flash flood alerts regularly through print and electronic media.
- Keep emergency medicines/kits and emergency food rations with themselves.
- Wear protective clothing and seek indoor shelter.
- Stay away from windows and doors during heavy rain and strong winds.
- Avoid roadway underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects there can be unexpectedly flood or overflow.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain due to poor visibility.
- Travelers and tourists are advised to remain extra cautious during the forecast period.
