**WEATHER OUTLOOK**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed the westerly wave is prevailing over the country.

Under the influence of this weather system rain/wind-thunderstorm of light (isolated moderate) intensity is expected in **Jacobabad, Qambar Shahdadt, Dadu, Jamshoro, Nausheroferoze, Shaheed Benazirabad, Larkana, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Khairpur Kashmore** and **Ghotki**, districts and **Karachi** division from evening/night of 7<sup>th</sup> November to 8<sup>th</sup> November.

**Impacts: -**

Day Temperatures likely to fall by 2-4 °C in the province.

In light of the forecast of PMD, concerned DDMA's, Rescue Departments, and other relevant agencies, NHA and local administrations are to ensure following measures:

- Immediate engagement of local communities to sensitize about developing weather and possible hazards.
- Mass awareness through all social/ media platforms; especially for the travellers/ tourists in the vulnerable areas.
- Ensure pre-positioning of machinery at identified choke points/ vulnerable areas.
- Local administration to ensure deployment of traffic wardens to manage traffic flow, create diversions and restrict movement as per the capacity of cities/ tourist spots.
- DDMA's to coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, FWO and Works & Services Depts) for restoration / clearance of roads in case of any blockage / obstruction.
- District Municipal Administrations to ensure mitigation measures for heavy rainfall / hailstorms / snowfall and road closures.
- All rescue services (Rescue 1122 / Fire Brigade / Ambulance / Civil Defence) and LEAs to remain alert and ensure availability of personnel and equipment during the forecasted period, especially in at-risk areas.
- Restrict vehicle movement in areas / nullahs prone to flash floods, low lying areas and close to water channels and landslide vulnerable locations.
- Local Administration / Departments to ensure that necessary arrangements are undertaken to avoid electrocution incidents and timely restoration of power supply, if required
- Immediate engagement of local communities to sensitize about developing weather and possible hazards.
- In case of any eventuality, special SITREP / update be shared immediately with PDMA Sindh.
