WEATHER OUTLOOK

Subject: RAIN-THUNDERSTORM WEATHER IS EXPECTED IN KARACHI AND MOST PARTS OF THE PROVINCE

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a press release dated 15th July, 2022, that for next 24 hours, widespread dust/rain-thunderstorms with a few heavy falls (very heavy at times) are likely to occur at evening/night in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparker, TM Khan, Tando Allayar, Sanghar, Nawabshah, Noushero-Feroz, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Qambar-Shahdadkot, Dadu, Jamshoro, Shikarpur, Ghotki & Kashmore districts.

For the next 48 hours, widespread dust/rain-thunderstorms with a few heavy falls (very heavy at times) are likely to occur evening/night in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparker, TM Khan, Tando Allayar, Sanghar, Nawabshah, Noushero-Feroz, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Qambar-Shahdadkot, Dadu, Jamshoro, Shikarpur, Ghotki & Kashmore districts.

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairmen DDMA other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary precautionary measures including:

- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure provision of water and necessary emergency medicines to the general public during emergency.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Emergency Services / Fire Brigades to remain alert for possible fire incidents and ensure preventive measures against fires due to electrification, where possible.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to the rainfall.
