**WEATHER OUTLOOK**

**Subject** **DEPRESSION OVER THE NORTHEAST ARABIAN SEA TO CAUSE ISOLATED HEAVY FALLS**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a press release dated 18<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, that, the Depression over Northeast Arabian Sea further moved nearly westward during last 12 hours, weakened this morning into a well-marked low pressure area (WML) and now lies over central parts of North Arabian Sea, **southwest of Karachi** with its trough extending to **lower Sindh & coastal Balochistan**. Also, monsoon currents are penetrating in **central and upper Sindh from Rajasthan, India side**.

Under its influence, Rain-thunderstorms with few heavy falls are likely in **Karachi division, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Mirpurkhas, Thaparker, Umerkot, Sanghar, Tando Muhammad Khan (TMK), Tando Allayar (TAY), Dadu, Jamshoro, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Noushero Feroz, Sanghar, Nawabshah, Ghotki, Kambar Shahdadkot, Khairpur and Kashmore** districts of Sindh **today**.

**POSSIBLE IMPACTS:**

- Windstorm may damage the loose & vulnerable structures.
- Sea conditions may become very Rough during the **Forecast period**.
- Fishermen are advised, not to venture in open sea during the **Forecast period**.

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairmen DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures including:

- Deputy Commissioners of the coastal districts to ensure that fishermen do not venture into open sea in the forecast period.
- Coordinate with all authorities to ensure smooth flow of storm water drains in Urban areas.
- Ensure coordination with all relevant authorities of Balochistan for information sharing about flows of Nullahs in adjoining areas of Balochistan and monitor their water level constantly, due to which flash flooding may occur in the adjoining districts of Sindh.
- Ensure early warning mechanism for evacuation of vulnerable population in areas/ districts in case of flash flooding.
- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.





- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.
- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure provision of water and necessary emergency medicines to the general public during emergency.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Emergency Services / Fire Brigades to remain alert for possible fire incidents and ensure preventive measures against fires due to electrification, where possible.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

**FOR GENERAL PUBLIC**

- Wear protective clothing and seek indoor shelter.
- Stay away from windows and doors during heavy rain and strong winds.
- Avoid roadway underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects there can be unexpectedly flood or overflow.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain due to poor visibility.
- Travelers and tourists are advised to remain extra cautious during the forecast period.
