Subject

RAIN-SNOWFALL OVER THE HILLS PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY

Met Office informed that after a long dry spell, a westerly wave has entered in Northwestern parts of Balochistan and likely to grip upper and central parts of the country on 28^{th} (night) and may persist till 29^{th} December.

Under The Influence of This Weather

• Light rain is expected in Sukkur, Larkana and Jacobabad.

Possible Impacts

- Rain will be beneficial for the standing crops specially in Barani areas.
- Foggy conditions are likely to subside during the forecast period.

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairmen DDMAs and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures including:

- Establishment of helpline number to address needs of rain/flood affected people/IDPs at priority basis.
- Ensure provision of water and necessary emergency medicines to the general public/IDPs during Emergency.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in flood affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Emergency Services / Fire Brigades to remain alert for possible fire incidents and ensure preventive measures against fires due to electrification, where possible.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

FOR GENERAL PUBLIC/IDPs:

- Monitor the weather alerts through print and electronic media.
- Install a smoke detector and carbon monoxide detector in residential/commercial buildings/homes and make sure that their batteries are working.
- Dress warmly and limit exposure to the cold to prevent frostbite and avoid getting wet to prevent hypothermia.
- Keep emergency medicines/kits and enough snacks / food especially dry food items in stock.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from cold weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Travelers and tourists undertaking urgent / unavoidable travel on roads during foggy conditions, to ensure safe minimum distance between vehicles at reduced speed (as per directions NH&MP / LEAs). Avoid driving during foggy condition due to poor visibility.
