**Subject WESTERLY WAVE CONTINUES TO STILL PERSIST OVER EAST
BALOCHISTAN**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a Westerly wave continues to still persist over East Balochistan. Under its influence, scattered rain-thunderstorms with occasional gusty winds are likely in Jamshoro, Dadu, Hyderabad, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allayar, Mirpurkhas districts during next 2 to 3 days especially at afternoon/evening, while in Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Kambar Shahdaddkot, Shikarpur, Kashmore, Ghotki, Naushero Feroze, Shaheed Benazirabad, Khairpur districts on 3-5 May with gaps. Isolated rain-thunderstorms may also occur in outskirts of Karachi today evening/night.

Possible Impacts

- Heavy falls may generate water logging in low lying areas of Kambar Shahdaddkot, Larkana, Dadu, Jamshoro, Sanghar, Matiari, Badin, Tando Muhammad Khan, Thatta & Sujawal districts.
- Strong winds may cause damage to loose & vulnerable structures.

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures. including:

- Establishment of helpline number to address needs of rain/flood affected people/IDPs at priority basis.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in flood affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

FOR GENERAL PUBLIC/IDPs:

- Monitor the weather alerts through print and electronic media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Sea conditions may become Rough. Fishermen should be advised not to venture in the sea and take extra care during the period
