Subject WESTERLY WAVE LIKELY TO ENTER IN SOUTHERN BALOCHISTAN

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a fresh westerly wave likely to enter southern Balochistan from today. Under its influence; scattered dust- thunderstorm/rain with few moderate to isolated heavy falls & hailstorm likely to occur in Dadu, Jamshoro, kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Kashmore, Sukkur, Ghotki, Khairpur, Naushahro Feroze, Shaheed Benazirabad, Sanghar & Matiari districts. Dust/thunderstorm-rain of moderate intensity are also expected in Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal districts & Karachi division from tomorrow till 1st May with occasional gaps

### **Possible Impacts**

- Heavy falls may generate water logging in low lying areas of Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Dadu, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Sanghar, Matiari & Badin districts
- Strong winds may cause damage to loose & vulnerable structures

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairman DDMAs and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures. including:

- Establishment of helpline number to address needs of rain/flood affected people/IDPs at priority basis.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in flood affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.
- Sea conditions may become Rough. Fishermen should be advised not to venture in the sea and take extra care during the period

## **FOR GENERAL PUBLIC/IDPs:**

- Monitor the weather alerts through print and electronic media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
