Subject <u>WESTERLY WAVE PERSISTS OVER SOUTH BALOCHISTAN</u>

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a fresh westerly wave persists over South Balochistan and likely to spread over Sindh today. Under its influence; scattered dust- thunderstorm/rain with few moderate to isolated heavy falls & hailstorm likely to occur in Dadu, Jamshoro, kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Kashmore, Sukkur, Ghotki, Khairpur, Naushahro Feroze and Shaheed Benazirabad from today 1st May. While Dust/thunderstorm-rain of moderate intensity are also expected in Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparker, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal districts & Karachi division till 1st May with few heavy falls in Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allahyar, Hyderabad, Sanghar, Matiari, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparkar, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal districts and Karachi division on Sunday with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts

- Heavy falls may generate water logging in low lying areas of Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana, Dadu, Jamshoro,
 Tando Muhammad Khan, Thatta, Sanghar, Matiari & Badin districts
- Strong winds may cause damage to loose & vulnerable structures

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairman

DDMAs and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures. including:

- Establishment of helpline number to address needs of rain/flood affected people/IDPs at priority basis.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in flood affected areas.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

FOR GENERAL PUBLIC/IDPs:

- Monitor the weather alerts through print and electronic media.
- Stay indoor unless absolutely necessary. Keep doors and windows shut and avoid sitting near windows as rain is often accompanied by strong winds.
- Maintain a distance from power lines or electrical wires. If you notice any loose electric wires in your area, alert
 the authorities immediately.
- Avoid touching electrical switches or outlets while it is raining. Do not try using electrical sockets or outlets
 outdoors while it is raining.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain because of poor visibility.
- Avoid underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects.
- Check on family members who are especially at risk from weather hazards: young children, older adults, and the chronically ill.
- Sea conditions may become Rough. Fishermen should be advised not to venture in the sea and take extra care during the period


