### **WEATHER WARNING**

Subject: STRONG MONSOON CURRENTS PENETRATING INTO EASTERN SINDH AND WILL PREVAIL TILL 26<sup>TH</sup>/27<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2022

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Weather Warning dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2022, that **strong monsoon currents** have started penetrating into eastern Sindh and will prevail till **26<sup>th</sup> July / 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2022.** 

### Under the influence of this weather system:

Widespread rain-wind/thunderstorms with scattered heavy/very heavy falls (extremely heavy at times in lower & western Sindh) are likely in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Tando M Khan, Tando Allayar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Sanghar, Nawabshah, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Naushero Feroz, Dadu, Jamshoro, Shikarpur, Kambar Shahdadkot, Ghotki and Kashmore districts from today to 26<sup>th</sup>, July and in Karachi division from tomorrow to 26<sup>th</sup>, July 2022.

### **Possible Impacts**

- Heavy/very heavy rainfall may generate urban flooding/water-logging in low lying areas of Karachi, Hyderabad, Matiari, Thatta, Badin, Mirpurkhas, Umerkot, Tharparker, Tando M Khan, Tando Allayar, Sanghar, Naushero Feroz Nawabshah, Dadu, Jamshoro, Kambar Shahdadkot, Larkana and Sukkur during the forecast period
- Strong winds may damage vulnerable & loose structures.
- Persistent heavy spell over Khuzdar, Lasbella, Hub & along Kirthar Range may create
  pressure on Hub Dam and Flash Flooding in Dadu and Jamshoro districts and
  downstream.

Keeping in view above, it is recommended that concerned Deputy Commissioners/ Chairmen DDMAs and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures including:

- Ensure early warning mechanism for evacuation of vulnerable population in areas/districts in case of flash flooding.
- Ensure availability of dewatering machines and the staff during rainfall.
- Improve coordination with emergency services, also with various line departments.

- Establishment of helpline Cell number to address needs of affected people at priority basis.
- Ensure provision of water and necessary emergency medicines to the general public during emergency.
- Stockpile necessary emergency relief/ medicine stores especially in affected areas.
- Keep the machinery on standby for plugging in breeches to LBOD/drainage network/ canals.
- Ensure availability of uninterrupted power supply through intimate coordination with concerned line departments and provision / availability of standby generators for hospitals.
- Emergency services and ambulances with trained paramedics to remain available round the clock.
- Emergency Services / Fire Brigades to remain alert for possible fire incidents and ensure preventive measures against fires due to electrification, where possible.
- Coordinate with concerned departments (NHA, NH&MP and FWO) for issuing necessary alerts to travelers, especially over long distances to take precaution and avoid over exposure to rainfall.

#### FOR GENERAL PUBLIC

- Move to safe places in case of any risk of Flash Flooding.
- Monitor the weather updates and flash flood alerts regularly through print and electronic media.
- Keep emergency medicines/kits and emergency food rations with themselves.
- Wear protective clothing and seek indoor shelter.
- Stay away from windows and doors during heavy rain and strong winds.
- Avoid roadway underpasses, drainage ditches, low-lying areas and areas where water collects there can be unexpectedly flood or overflow.
- Avoid driving in heavy rain due to poor visibility.

• Travelers and tourists are advised to remain extra cautious during the forecast period.
