Distribution of NFI & Hygiene Kits

Flood affected Older People and Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) have improved access to Non Food Items including hygiene kits.

Distribution of Cash Grants

Flood affected vulnerable Older People & Persons with Disabilities (PWDs) and ultra-poor vulnerable households have access to life-saving humanitarian needs through Multipurpose Cash Grants.

No. of households reached till date: **439**

Number of Beneficiaries reached till date: **2634**



Distribution of Temporary Shelter Kits

As part of immediate response, HAI provided Shelter kits to Flood Affected population particularly to households run by Older People amidst heavy flooding.

No. of households reached till date: **250**

Number of Beneficiaries reached till date: **1500**



Distribution of Mobility Aid and Assistive Devices

Older People are worst affected during times of natural calamities owing to limited access to healthcare or basic life necessities. With a strong emphasis on access and inclusive humanitarian response, HAI distributed mobility aid items to flood affected Older People and PWDs in flood affected districts.

Risk Communication & Community Engagement

Community Engagement to raise awareness on issues related to floods such as water borne diseases and Mass-media Campaigns in local languages in most remote areas of Pakistan.

Planned Activities

Psycho-Social Support Sessions

HAI will be conducting psycho-social support sessions Older People and PWDs suffering from trauma in flood affected districts.

Distribution of Protection Kits

HAI will be distributing Protection Kits to Flood affected Older People to reduce flood related risks and vulnerabilities.

Distribution of Bedding Kits

HAI will be disseminating Bedding Kits to 2,150 households affected by recent flooding across Sindh and Balochistan.

Distribution of Dignity Kits

HAI brought a sharp focus on urgent needs of women during flooding and distributed Dignity kits in flood affected districts.
