WARNING - I

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Weather Outlook, dated, 05th August, 2022, that, the monsoon currents of moderate intensity started entering in eastern Sindh.

Rain-thunderstorms with a few moderate (Isolated heavy) falls is expected in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin Tando Muhammad khan, Tando Allayar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Thatta, Sujawal, Sanghar, Shaheed Benazirabad, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Dadu, Jamshoro & Kambar Shahdadkot districts during 5th -9th August. While, rain-thunderstorm is also expected in Karachi division during 6th -9th August.

WARNING - II

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Press Release, dated, 05th August, 2022, 1430 hours that, monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in the country likely to become stronger from 10th August (Wednesday).

Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is expected in southeastern Sindh from 06th to 09th August with occasional gaps. Rain-wind/thunderstorm with scattered heavy falls are expected in Sindh from 10th to 13th August with occasional gaps.

Heavy Rains may generate urban flooding in Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Hyderabad, Dadu, Jamshoro, Sukkur, Larkana, Shaheed Benazirabad and Mirpurkhas from 11th to 13th August.
