5. <u>Weather Warning for Sindh:</u>

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Monsoon Outlook, dated, 07th August, 2022, that, the monsoon currents continue to penetrate in Sindh which likely to become stronger from 9th August onwards.

Rain-thunderstorms with a few moderate (isolate heavy) falls is expected in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Tando Muhammad khan, Tando Allayar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Thatta, Sujawal, Sanghar, Shaheed Benazirabad, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Dadu, Jamshoro & Kambar Shahdadkot districts & Karacki division till tomorrow & likely to become intense during 9th August – 13th August.

Rainfall intensity also to increase from 10th August in northeastern & southern districts of Balochistan which may trigger flash flooding in Dadu, Jamshoro, Kambar Shahdadkot districts & downstream.
