5. **Weather Warning for Sindh:**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Monsoon Outlook, dated, 10th August, 2022, that, the monsoon currents continue to penetrate in Sindh and likely to become stronger from tomorrow.

- **Rain-thunderstorms with a few moderate (isolate heavy) falls** is expected in **Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allayar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Thatta, Sujawal, Sanghar, Shaheed Benazirabad, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Dadu, Jamshoro and Kambar Shahdadkot districts and Karachi division** and is likely to become intense & widespread **up to 14th August**.
- **Rainfall intensity also to increase from 12th August** in northeastern and southern districts of Balochistan which may trigger flash flooding in **Dadu, Jamshoro, Kambar Shahdadkot districts and downstream**
