adjoining Rann of Kutch, India with its trough extending up to **southern Sindh**. The low-pressure over Rajasthan, India also persists.

- **Rain-thunderstorms with a few heavy/very heavy falls & occasional strong winds** are very likely in **Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allayar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Thatta, Sujawal, Sanghar, Shaheed Benazirabad, Noushero Feroz, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Dadu, Jamshoro & Kambar Shahdadkot districts & Karachi division** till **14<sup>th</sup> August** with occasional gaps.
- Rainfall intensity also to increase in northeastern and southern districts of Balochistan which may trigger flash flooding in **Dadu, Jamshoro, Kambar Shahdadkot districts & downstream**.

#### DEPRESSION WARNING – I

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Press Release-I, dated, 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, at 1400 hours, that, the **well-marked low-pressure area (WML)** over Northeast Arabian Sea has **intensified** into a **Depression (Intense Low-Pressure Area)** with maximum wind speed of **50-55 km/hour**. The system is located around Latitude 22.6N & Longitude 66.4E, at a distance of about **260km south/southeast of Karachi** and **280km from Thatta**. This weather system is likely to move in northwest direction initially and then westwards.

**Currently none of Pakistan coastal area is under any threat from this weather system.** PMD Tropical Cyclone Warning Centre, Karachi is closely monitoring the system and updates will be issued accordingly.

#### DEPRESSION WARNING – II

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Depression Alert II, dated, 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2022, at 2200 hours, that, the **Depression (Intense Low-Pressure Area)** over Northeast Arabian Sea has moved nearly in west-northwest direction during last 8 hours and now located near Latitude 22.5N and Longitude 65.0 E, at a distance of about **330km southwest of Karachi, 370km from Thatta and 290km south of Ormara**. Maximum sustained surface winds are **45km/hour** gusting to **55km/hour** around the system centre. The system is likely to move further in west-northwest direction.

**Currently none of Pakistan coastal area is under any threat** from this weather system. PMD Tropical Cyclone Warning Centre, Karachi is closely monitoring the system and updates will be issued accordingly.
