5. **Weather Warning for Sindh:**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) vide its heavy monsoon rains alert dated: 21.08.2022, has informed that an accentuated seasonal low persist over Balochistan and upper Sindh. Another strong low-pressure area currently located over central India likely to approach Sindh from **23rd August** which may cause again moderate/heavy rain-thunderstorms in most of the **Districts of Sindh** during **23-26 August**.

- Rain-thunderstorms with few moderate/heavy falls likely to continue in **Noshero Feroz, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur, Jacobabad, Dadu & Kambar Shahdadkot Districts** till tomorrow.
- Light rain/drizzle likely in **Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Tano Muhammad Khan, Tando Allayar, Hyderabad, Mityari, Thatta, Sujawal Districts & Karachi Division**.
- The continuing wet spell over northeastern & southern districts of Balochistan to persist till **22 August** which may trigger flash flooding in **Dadu, Jamshoro, Kambar Shahdadkot Districts & downstream**.
