Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) vide its **Heavy Monsoon Rains Alert** dated: 23.08.2022, has informed that a strong monsoon low-pressure area lies over east Rajasthan (India) with its trough extending up to eastern Sindh.

- Rain-thunderstorms with few heavy/very heavy falls likely to occur in **Tharparker, Mirpur Khas, Umerkot, Thatta, Sujawal, Badin, Sanghar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allayar, Shaheed. Benazirabad, Dadu, Jamshoro, Kambar Shahdadkot, Khairpur, Naushahro Feroze, Jacobabad, Shikarpur, Ghotki, Sukkur, Larkana & Kashmore Districts** from **today to 25 August**.
