5. Weather Warning for Sindh:

(As per Pakistan Meteorological Department)

Weather Alert (I)

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Weather Warning dated 26th July, 2022, that, the low-pressure area causing widespread heavy rains in Sindh still persists with another Low-pressure formed over west Rajasthan, India.

Rain/thunderstorms with a few heavy falls likely to continue in Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Badin, Thatta, Sujawal, Tando M Khan, TandoAllayar, Hyderabad, Matiari, Sanghar, Nawabshah, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Dadu, Jamshoro, Shikarpur, Qambar Shahdadkot, Ghotki & Kashmore districts and Karachi division till 27 July (night).

Weather Alert (II)

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Press Release dated 26th July, 2022, 1300 PST that monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in the country and likely to shift and intensify in upper and central parts of the country from 27th July (Wednesday).

More rain-wind/thundershower (with few heavy falls) are expected in Dadu, Sukkur, Larkana and Jaccobabad from 27th to 31st July with occasional gaps.

7. **Flood Warning/Alert:** FLASH FLOOD ALERT

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has informed vide its Press Release dated 22th July, 2022, afternoon, that, the latest Meteorological conditions strong monsoon currents affecting upper parts of the country likely to enter Sindh and northeast/east Balochistan from tonight/tomorrow.

Under the influence this weather system and possible interaction of moist currents from the North Arabian Sea, widespread rain-wind/thunderstorms with scattered heavy/ very heavy are likely to occur in Dadu, Qambar Shahdadkot and Jamshoro districts of Sindh during 23-26 July and Hub districts of Balochistan and along Kirthar Range during 24-26 July 2022.

The persistent heavy spell may trigger flash flood/hill torrents in local nullas/streams that potentially can affect low-lying areas in Dadu, Jamshoro, Qamber Shahdadkot and Hub districts during 24-26 July.

Heavy/very rainy spell in Khuzdar, Lasbella, Hub districts and other catchment areas would increase water inflow and exert more pressure on the Hub Dam during the forecast period.

Particularly, the vulnerable areas of Drigh, Serai Lund, Tribal Lund, Sajjan Joon Payoon, Kululli Laghari, Rajo Gghado, Guhram Jo Goth, Nagar Dharyo, Baghnel, Haji Khan, Wahi, UC Sawero of Taluka Johi (Dadu district) could be affected due to flooding from Nai Gaj.
