

3. Flood Relief Activities:

Last 24 Hours: 4189.5 KG relief items containing (40 Ration Bags, 76.5 Kg Cooking Oil, 400 Anti Snake Vaccines and Medicines / Medical Supplies) handed over to Air Force Authorities for further dispatch to Balochistan. This is in addition to 600 tents sent earlier for the flood affectees of Uthal. Balochistan.

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed vide its Weather Warning dated 30th July 2022, that, the trough over northeast Sindh has merged with low over Balochistan. Light rain with isolated thunderstorm expected in Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Dadu, Shikarpur and Qambar Shahdadkot Ghotki & Kashmore districts, while light rain/drizzle is likely to occur in Karachi division, Thatta, Sujawal and Badin districts.
