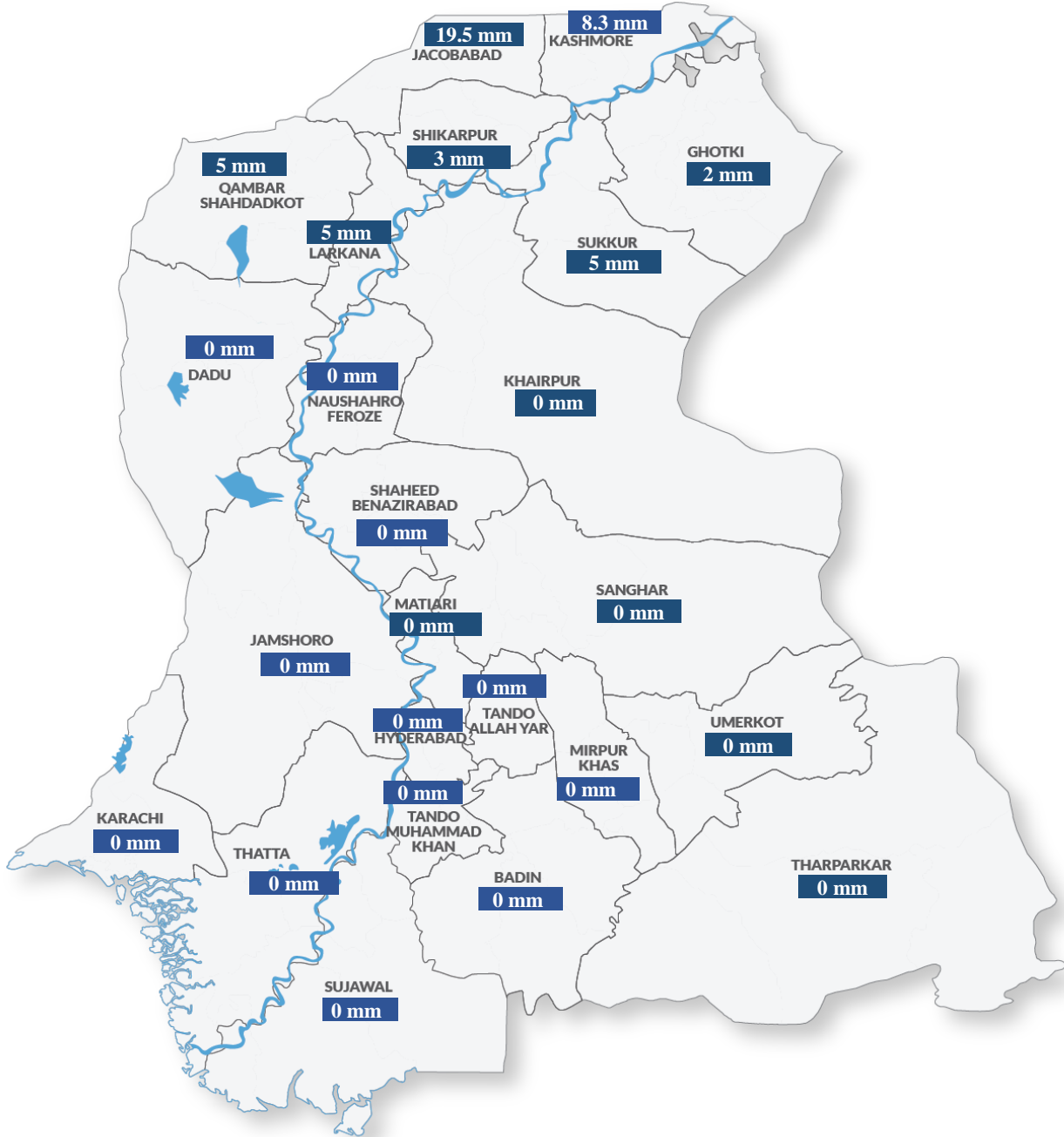

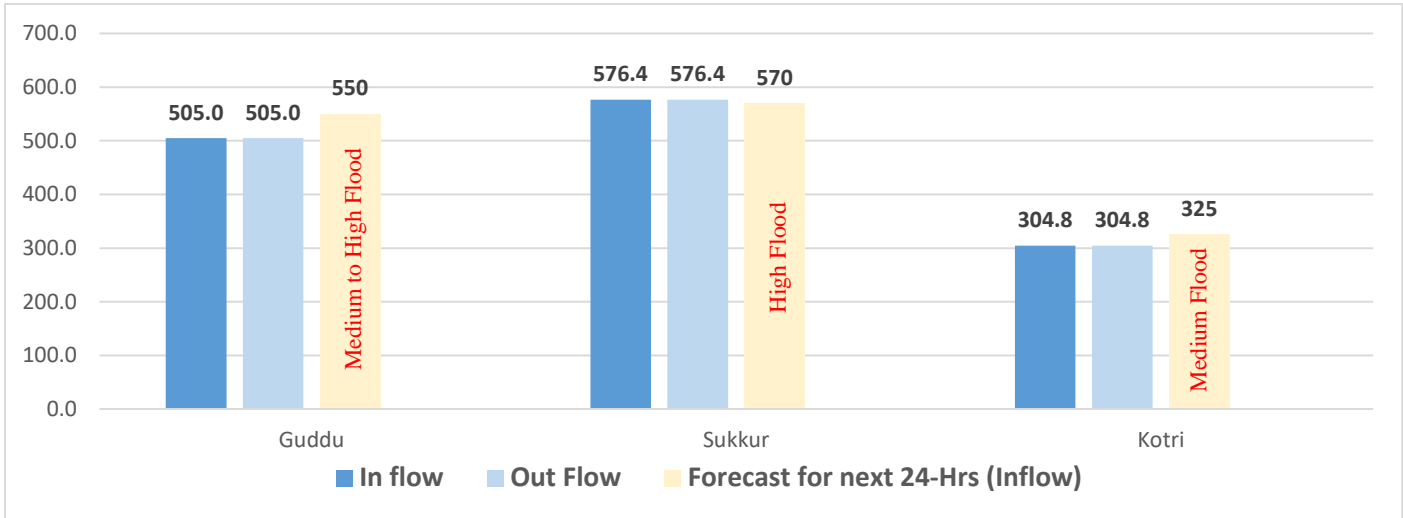

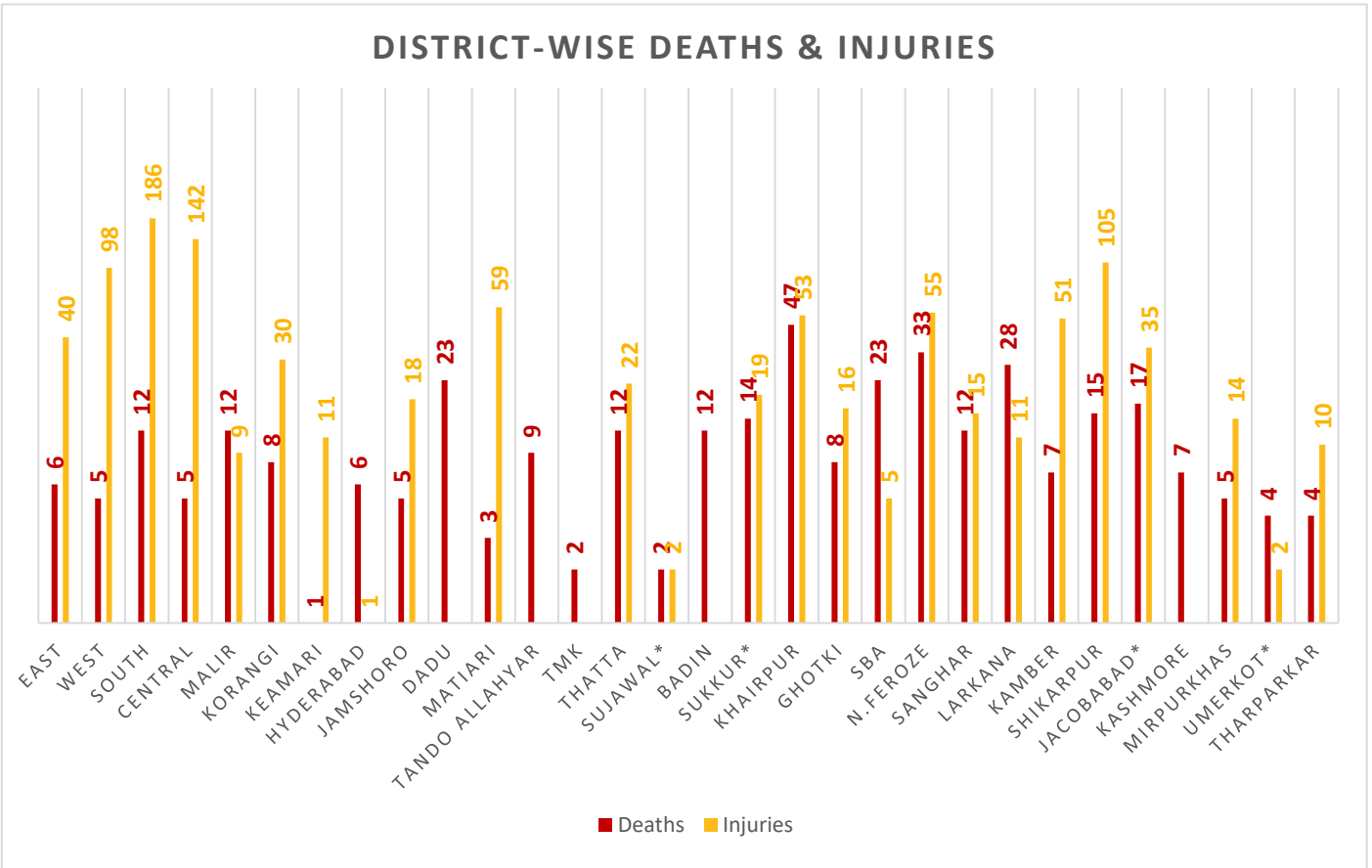

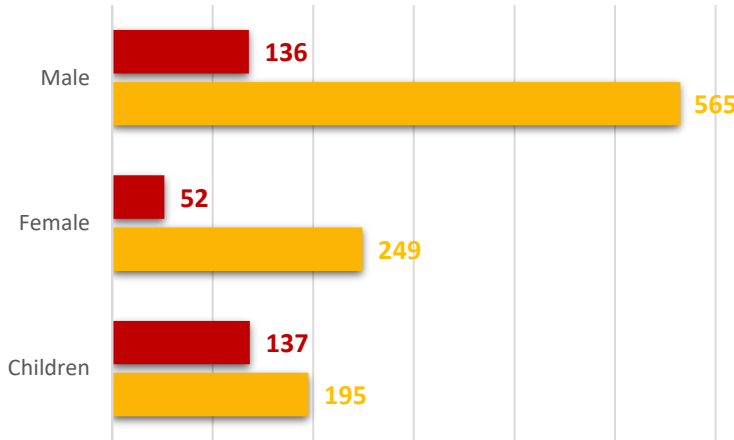

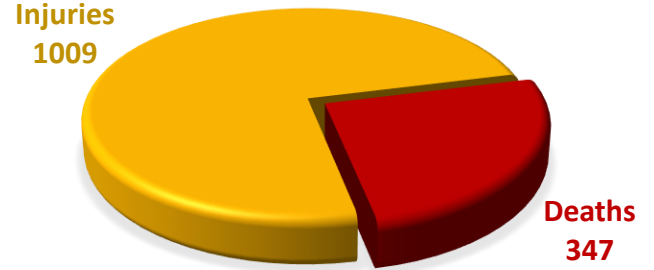

### GENDER-WISE DISTRIBUTION



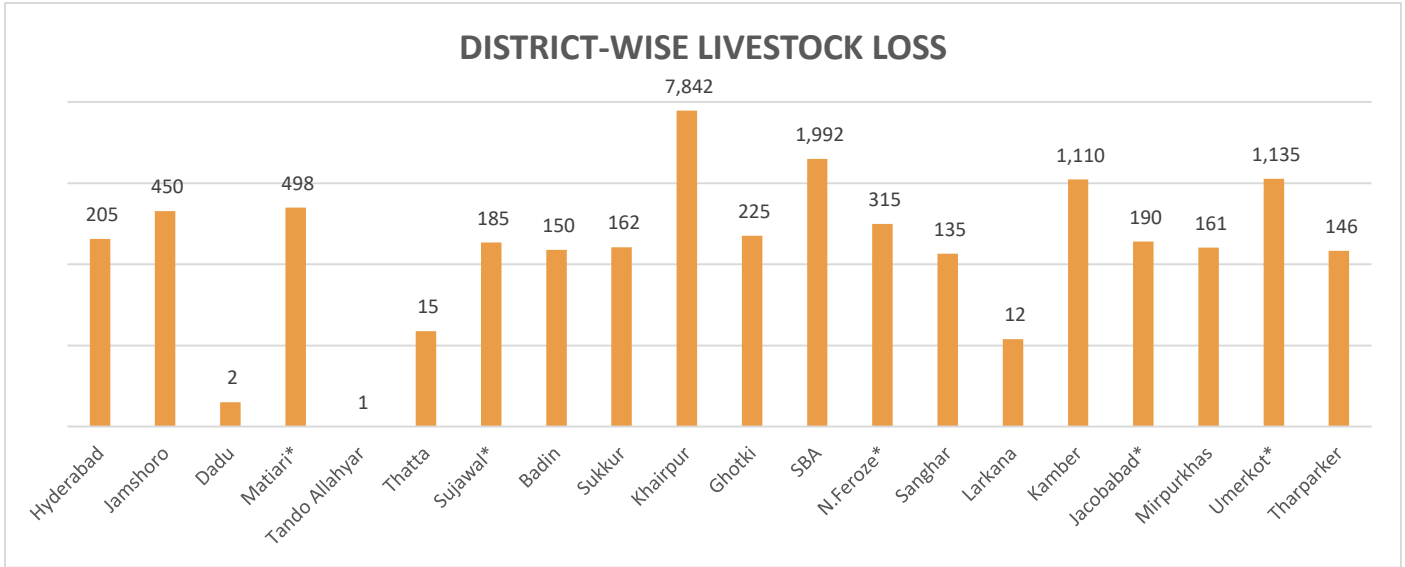
