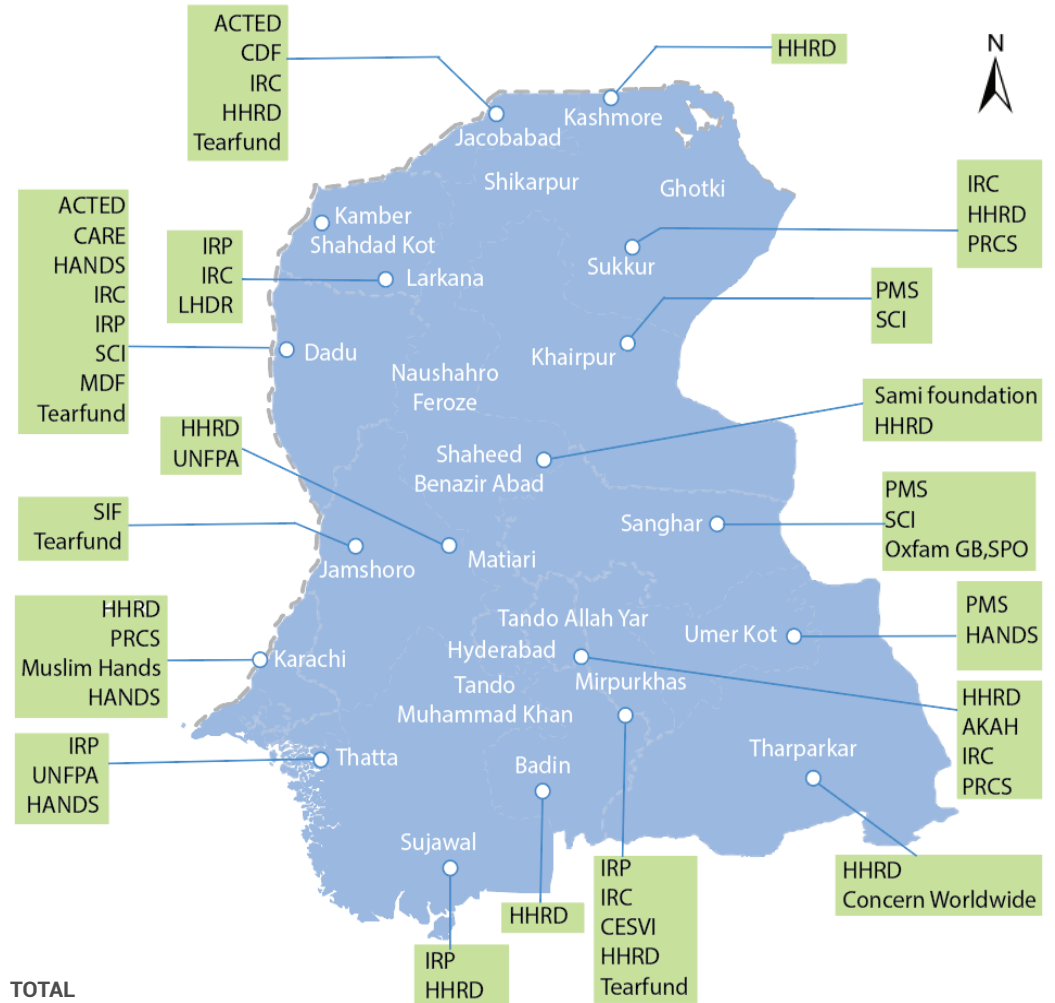


## Progress on Heatwave

- PDMA Sindh has taken anticipatory actions to mitigate the impacts of Heatwave which include timely issuance of heatwave alerts/advisories, circulation of department SOPs among provincial line departments and other stakeholders, initiating mass awareness campaign through print, electronic & social media platforms in Sindhi, Urdu, & English languages.
- PDMA Sindh conducted 1st Heatwave Humanitarian Coordination meeting on 18th May 2024, meeting minutes circulated on same day.
- PDMA and DDMA are closely monitoring the situation/ Heatwave Response Plan.
- PDMA and DDMA established control rooms for quick and smooth coordination and facilitation .
- Deputy Commissioners / Chairmen DDMA issued circulars / advisories regarding preventive measures in respective districts.
- Deputy Commissioners / Chairmen DDMA identified sites for establishment of heat stabilization camps / centers with staff assigned on duties .
- Deputy Commissioners / Chairmen DDMA established heatwave stabilization camps in collaboration with different Humanitarian Partners in various districts .
- 19 Humanitarian Partners staff engaged/deployed in Heatwave response plan in different districts.
- 19 Humanitarian Partners conducted awareness session on heatwave by providing community sessions , distribution of Information, Education & Communication material , display of Banners, awareness raising through social and local media-approved by PDMA
- 19 Humanitarian Partners providing support in safe transportation/ shifting of referred patients from Camps to Heat stroke centers / hospitals .
