Subject: **HEATWAVE ALERT**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure likely to grip the upper atmosphere from 13th April, due to which heatwave conditions may develop in most parts of the country and is expected to change into **severe heatwave conditions in southern half from 14th April**, where day temperatures are likely to remain **06-08 °C** above normal from **13th to 18th April**.

Possible Impacts:

- Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities (wheat harvesting) keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- In case of wind-duststorm may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels at vulnerable locations.

2. In view of the above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/ Chairman DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities / stakeholders are requested to take necessary precautionary measures.

Heatwave Alert:

Heatwave conditions predicted in the country during next week

Met office predicted that a high pressure is likely to grip the upper atmosphere from 13th April, due to which heatwave conditions may develop in most parts of the country and is expected to change into **severe heatwave conditions in southern half from 14th (Monday).**

- Day temperatures are likely to remain **06 to 08°C above normal in southern half** (Sindh, southern Punjab and Balochistan) from 13th to 18th April.
- Day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C above normal** in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) from 14th to 18th April.
- Nights will also be warmer during the forecast period.
- Excessive heating/rising temperatures may generate duststorm/windstorm during the forecast period.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- **Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.**
- **Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities (wheat harvesting) keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**
- **Rising temperatures tendency in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate from 14th to 18th April.**
- **In case of wind-duststorm may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels at vulnerable locations.**

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.

آئندہ ہفتے کے دوران ملک میں گرمی کی لہر کی پیش گوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق 13 اپریل سے فضا میں ہوا کا زیادہ دباؤ ملک کے بیشتر علاقوں پر اثر انداز ہو گا جس کے باعث ملک کے بیشتر علاقے گرمی کی لہر کی لپیٹ میں رہیں گے۔ جو کہ 14 اپریل (پیر) سے ملک کے بیشتر جنوبی علاقے شدید گرمی کی لہر کے زیر اثر ہوں گے۔

- ملک کے جنوبی علاقوں (سندھ، جنوبی پنجاب اور بلوچستان) میں 13 سے 18 اپریل کے دوران دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 06 سے 08 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کا امکان۔
- ملک کے بالائی علاقوں (وسطی/بالائی پنجاب، اسلام آباد، خیبر پختونخوا، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان) میں 14 سے 18 اپریل کے دوران دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 04 سے 06 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کا امکان۔
- اس دوران راتیں بھی گرم ہوں گی۔
- گرمی کی لہر کے باعث آندھی/جھکڑ چلنے کی توقع۔

محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے عوام الناس بالخصوص بچوں، خواتین اور بزرگ شہریوں کو احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کا مشورہ۔
 - دن کے دوران دھوپ میں کم سے کم نکلا جائے۔ اور پانی کا زیادہ استعمال کریں۔
 - کاشت کار حضرات گندم کی فصل کے معاملات موسمی حالات کے مطابق ترتیب دیں۔ اور اپنے جانوروں کو گرم موسم سے محفوظ رکھیں۔
 - 14 سے 18 اپریل کے دوران شمالی علاقوں میں درجہ حرارت میں اضافہ برف پگھلنے کی شرح کو بڑھا سکتا ہے۔
 - گرد آلود ہوائیں/آندھی کے باعث کمزور سڑک پر مثلاً بجلی کے کھمبے، درخت، گاڑیاں اور سولر بینل متاثر ہونے کا خدشہ۔
- نوٹ:** تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو "ہیٹ ویلرٹ" رہنے اور گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
