Subject: **SEVERE HEATWAVE PREDICTED DURING EID HOLIDAYS AND COMING WEEK**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure likely to develop over the country on 07th June and is expected to grip most parts from 08th June. Under the influence of these meteorological conditions, day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C above normal** in Southern half (Upper and Central Sindh) from **07th to 12th June**.

Possible Impacts:

- Due to severe heatwave conditions, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and stay hydrated.
- Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities accordingly.

In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/6290 dated: 27-02-2025, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts.

Severe Heatwave Alert:

Severe heatwave predicted during Eid holidays and coming week

Met office predicted that high pressure is likely to develop over the country on 07th June and is expected to grip most parts from 08th June. Under the influence of these meteorological conditions:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain **05 to 07°C above normal** in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) **from 07th to 12th June.**
- Day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C above normal in southern half** (upper and central Sindh, southern Punjab and parts of Balochistan) **from 07th to 12th June.**
- Duststorm/gusty-winds are expected over the plains of the country due to excessive heating.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- **Due to severe heatwave conditions, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.**
- **Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and stay hydrated.**
- **Rising temperatures in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate during the forecast period.**
- **Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities accordingly.**

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to severe heatwave conditions.

عید کی تعطیلات اور آئندہ ہفتے کے دوران شدید گرمی کی لہر کی پیش گوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق 07 جون سے ہوا کا زیادہ دباؤ ملک پر اثر انداز ہو گا اور 08 جون سے ملک کے بیشتر علاقوں کو اپنی لپیٹ میں لینے کا امکان۔ جس کے باعث:

- 07 سے 12 جون کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں (وسطی/ بالائی پنجاب، اسلام آباد، خیبر پختونخوا، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 05 سے 07 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کی توقع۔
- 07 سے 12 جون کے دوران ملک کے جنوبی علاقوں (بالائی/ وسطی سندھ، جنوبی پنجاب اور بلوچستان کے علاقوں) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 04 سے 06 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کا امکان۔
- شدید گرمی کے باعث ملک کے میدانی علاقوں میں تیز/ گرد آلود ہوائیں چلنے کی توقع۔

محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے عوام الناس بالخصوص بچوں، خواتین اور بزرگ شہریوں کو احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کا مشورہ۔
 - دن کے دوران دھوپ میں کم سے کم نکلیں۔ اور پانی کا زیادہ استعمال کریں۔
 - شمالی علاقوں میں درجہ حرارت میں اضافہ برف پگھلنے کی شرح کو بڑھا سکتا ہے۔
 - زندگی کے تمام شعبوں میں پانی کے مناسب استعمال کی ہدایت۔
 - کاشت کار حضرات فصلوں کے معاملات موسمی حالات کے مطابق ترتیب دیں۔
- نوٹ: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو ”لہر“ رہنے اور شدید گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
