Subject: **HEATWAVE IS LIKELY TO CONTINUE DURING THE CURRENT WEEK**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure likely to persist in upper atmosphere during the current week. Under its influence, day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C above normal** in Sindh from **20<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> May**.

**Possible Impacts:**

- Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities (wheat harvesting) keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- In case of wind-duststorm may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels at vulnerable locations.

2. In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/6290 dated: 27-02-2025, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts.

**Heatwave Alert:**

**Heatwave is likely to continue during the current week**

Met office predicted that a high pressure is likely to persist in upper atmosphere during the current week. Under the influence of this meteorological condition:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C** above normal in southern half (Sindh, southern Punjab and Balochistan) from 20<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> May.
- Day temperatures are likely to remain **05 to 07°C** above normal in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) from 20<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> May.
- Duststorm/gusty winds are expected at isolated places over plain areas due to excessive heating during the forecast period.

**Possible Impacts and advice:**

- **Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.**
- **Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the latest weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**
- **Rising temperatures in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate during the forecast period.**
- **Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.**

**Note:** All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق ہوا کا زیادہ دباؤ رواں ہفتے کے دوران بھی موجود رہنے کا امکان ہے۔ جس کے باعث:

- 20 سے 24 مئی کے دوران ملک کے جنوبی علاقوں (سندھ، جنوبی پنجاب اور بلوچستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 04 سے 06 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کا امکان۔
- 20 سے 24 مئی کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں (وسطی/بالائی پنجاب، اسلام آباد، خیبر پختونخوا، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 05 سے 07 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کی توقع۔

- اس دوران شدید گرمی کے باعث میدانی علاقوں میں چند مقامات پر آندھی/جھکڑ چلنے کی توقع۔

محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے عوام الناس بالخصوص بچوں، خواتین اور بزرگ شہریوں کو احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کا مشورہ۔
  - دن کے دوران دھوپ میں کم سے کم نکلا جائے۔ اور پانی کا زیادہ استعمال کریں۔
  - کاشت کار حضرات فصلوں کے معاملات موسمی حالات کے مطابق ترتیب دیں۔ اور اپنے جانوروں کو گرم موسم سے محفوظ رکھیں۔
  - شمالی علاقوں میں درجہ حرارت میں اضافہ برف پگھلنے کی شرح کو بڑھا سکتا ہے۔
  - زندگی کے تمام شعبوں میں پانی کے درست استعمال کی ہدایت۔
- نوٹ: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو ”الرٹ“ رہنے اور گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
