

HEATWAVE IS LIKELY TO CONTINUE DURING THE CURRENT WEEK Subject:

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure likely to persist in upper atmosphere during the current week. Under its influence, day temperatures are likely to remain 04 to 06°C above normal in Sindh from 20th to 24th May.

Possible Impacts:

- Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities (wheat harvesting) keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- In case of wind-duststorm may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels at vulnerable locations.
- In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/6290 dated: 27-02-2025, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts.



Heatwave Alert:

Heatwave is likely to continue during the current week

Met office predicted that a high pressure is likely to persist in upper atmosphere during the current week. Under the influence of this meteorological condition:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain <u>04 to 06°C</u> above normal in southern half (Sindh, southern Punjab and Balochistan) from 20th to 24th May.
- Day temperatures are likely to remain <u>05 to 07°C</u> above normal in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) from 20th to 24th May.
- Duststorm/gusty winds are expected at isolated places over plain areas due to excessive heating during the forecast period.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the latest weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- Rising temperatures in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate during the forecast period.
- Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.

<u>Note:</u> All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.

- 20 ہے 24 مئی کے دوران ملک کے بالا کی علاقوں (وسطی/بالا کی پنجاب،اسلام آباد، خیبر پختو نخوا، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان) میں دن کادر جه حرارت معمول سے <u>05 ہے 0</u>5 ڈ گری سینٹی گریڈزیادہ رہنج کی توقع۔
 - اس دوران شدید گرمی کے باعث میدانی علاقوں میں چند مقامات پر آند ھی/جھکڑ چلنے کی توقع۔
