Subject: **HEATWAVE CONDITIONS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY FROM 26<sup>TH</sup> TO 30<sup>TH</sup> APRIL**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure is likely to approach upper atmosphere from 26<sup>th</sup> April, and likely to grip most parts of the country on 27<sup>th</sup> April. Under the influence of this meteorological conditions, day temperatures are likely to remain **5-7°C** above normal in Southern half (Sindh) from **26<sup>th</sup> April to 01<sup>st</sup> May**.

**Possible Impacts and advice:**

- Due to heatwave conditions in the province, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.

In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/6290 dated: 27-02-2025, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts.

**Heatwave Alert:**

**Heatwave conditions predicted in the country from 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> April**

Met office predicted that a high pressure is likely to approach upper atmosphere from 26<sup>th</sup> April, and likely to grip most parts of the country on 27<sup>th</sup> April.

Under the influence of this meteorological conditions:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain **05 to 07°C above normal in southern half** (Sindh, southern Punjab and Balochistan) **from 26<sup>th</sup> April to 01<sup>st</sup> May.**
- Day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C above normal** in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) **from 27<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> April.**

A weather system is expected to enter upper parts of the country from 30<sup>th</sup> April. Rain-wind/thunderstorm (isolated heavyfalls/hailstorm) is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Pothohar region including northeast Punjab, upper Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan from 30<sup>th</sup> April/01<sup>st</sup> May. This system will subside the heatwave conditions in the country from 01<sup>st</sup> May onwards.

**Possible Impacts and advice:**

- **Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.**
- **Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities (wheat harvesting) keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**
- **Rising temperatures in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate, especially from 27<sup>th</sup> April to 01<sup>st</sup> May.**
- **Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.**
- **Wind-dust storm/hailstorm and lightning may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels in Islamabad, Pothohar region including northeast Punjab and parts of Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa on 30<sup>th</sup> April/01<sup>st</sup> May.**

**Note:** All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.

### 26 سے 30 اپریل کے دوران ملک میں گرمی کی لہر کی پیش گوئی

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق ہوا کا زیادہ دباؤ 26 اپریل سے بالائی فضا میں داخل ہو گا اور 27 اپریل کو ملک کے بیشتر علاقوں پر اثر انداز ہو گا۔

- 26 اپریل سے 01 مئی کے دوران ملک کے جنوبی علاقوں (سندھ، جنوبی پنجاب اور بلوچستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 05 سے 07 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کا امکان۔
- 27 سے 30 اپریل کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں (وسطی/بالائی پنجاب، اسلام آباد، خیبر پختونخوا، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 04 سے 06 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کا امکان۔

30 اپریل سے بارش کا سبب بننے والی ہوائیں ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کی پیش گوئی۔ کشمیر، اسلام آباد، خطہ پوٹھوہار سمیت شمال مشرقی پنجاب، بالائی خیبر پختونخوا اور گلگت بلتستان میں 30 اپریل/01 مئی سے آندھی/جھکڑ چلنے اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش/ژالہ باری کی توقع۔ 01 مئی سے ملک میں ہیٹ ویو (گرمی کی لہر) کی شدت میں کمی متوقع۔

#### محکمہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:

- گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے عوام الناس بالخصوص بچوں، خواتین اور بزرگ شہریوں کو احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کا مشورہ۔
- دن کے دوران دھوپ میں کم سے کم نکلا جائے۔ اور پانی کا زیادہ استعمال کریں۔
- کاشت کار حضرات گندم کی فصل کے معاملات موسمی حالات کے مطابق ترتیب دیں۔ اور اپنے جانوروں کو گرم موسم سے محفوظ رکھیں۔
- شمالی علاقوں میں درجہ حرارت میں اضافہ (خصوصاً 27 اپریل سے 01 مئی کے دوران) برف پگھلنے کی شرح کو بڑھا سکتا ہے۔
- زندگی کے تمام شعبوں میں پانی کے درست استعمال کی ہدایت۔
- 30 اپریل/01 مئی سے اسلام آباد، خطہ پوٹھوہار سمیت شمال مشرقی پنجاب اور خیبر پختونخوا کے علاقوں میں آندھی/جھکڑ/ژالہ باری/گرج چمک کے باعث کمزور سڑک پر مٹھا بجلی کے کھمبے، درخت، گاڑیاں اور سولر بینل متاثر ہونے کا خدشہ۔

نوٹ: تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو ”الرٹ“ رہنے اور گرمی کی لہر کی وجہ سے کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
