

Subject: HEATWAVE CONDITIONS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY FROM 26TH TO 30TH

APRIL

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure is likely to approach upper atmosphere from 26th April, and likely to grip most parts of the country on 27th April. Under the influence of this meteorological conditions, day temperatures are likely to remain 5-7°C above normal in Southern half (Sindh) from 26th April to 01st May.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- Due to heatwave conditions in the province, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care
 of their livestock as well.
- 2. In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/6290 dated: 27-02-2025, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts.

Date: 25th April, 2025 Time: 11:30 PST

Heatwave conditions predicted in the coutnry from 26th to 30th April

Met office predicted that a high pressure is likely to approach upper atmosphere from 26th April, and likely to grip most parts of the country on 27th April.

Under the influence of this meteorological conditions:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain <u>05 to 07°C</u> above normal in southern half (Sindh, southern Punjab and Balochistan) from 26th April to 01st May.
- Day temperatures are likely to remain <u>04 to 06°C</u> above normal in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) from 27th to 30th April.

A weather system is expected to enter upper parts of the country from 30th April. Rain-wind/thunderstorm (isolated heavyfalls/hailstorm) is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Pothohar region including northeast Punjab, upper Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan from 30th April/01st May. This system will subside the heatwave conditions in the country from 01st May onwards.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities (wheat harvesting) keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- Rising temperatures in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate, especially from 27th April to 01st May.
- Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.
- Wind-dust storm/hailstorm and lightning may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels in Islamabad, Pothohar region including northeast Punjab and parts of Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa on 30th April/01st May.

<u>Note:</u> All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق ہواکازیادہ دباؤ 26اپریل سے بالائی فضامیں داخل ہو گااور 27اپریل کوملک کے بیشتر علاقوں پراثرانداز ہوگا۔

- 26 اپریل سے 01 مئی کے دوران ملک کے جنوبی علاقوں (سندھ، جنوبی پنجاب اور بلوچتان) میں دن کادر جہ حرارت معمول سے 05 سے 07 ڈ گری سینٹی گریڈزیادہ رہنے کاامکان۔
- 27 <u>ہے 30 اپریل</u> کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں (وسطی/بالائی پنجاب،اسلام آباد، خیبر پختونخوا، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے <u>04 سے 06</u> ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کاامکان۔

01/پریل سے بارش کا سبب بننے والی ہوائیں ملک کے بالا کی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کی پیشگو کی۔ تشمیر، اسلام آباد، خطہ پو ٹھوہار سمیت شال مشرقی پنجاب، بالا کی خیبر پختو نخوااور گلگت بلتستان میں 30 اپریل/10 می سے آند ھی / جھکڑ چلنے اور گرج چیک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلاد ھاربارش/ ژالہ باری کی توقع۔ 01 مئی سے ملک میں ہیٹ ویو (گرمی کی لہر) کی شدت میں کمی متوقع۔

مكنه اثرات اوراحتياطي تدابير:

- محرمی کی اہر کی وجہ سے عوام الناس بالخصوص بچوں، خواتین اور بزرگ شہر یوں کو احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کامشورہ۔
 - دن کے دوران دھوپ میں تم سے کم لکلاجائے۔اور یانی کازیادہ استعال کریں۔
- - ثالی علاقوں میں درجہ حرارت میں اضافہ (خصوصاً 27 اپریل سے 01 مئ کے دوران) برف پکھلنے کی شرح کو بڑھا سکتا ہے۔
 - زندگی کے تمام شعبوں میں یانی کے درست استعال کی ہدایت۔
- 30 اپریل/01 مئی سے اسلام آباد، خطہ لو تھوبار سمیت ثال مشرقی پنجاب اور خیبر پختو نخوا کے علاقوں میں آند ھی/ جھڑ / ژالہ باری/ گرج چیک کے باعث کمزور سٹر کچر مثلاً بجل کے تھیے، درخت، گاڑیاں اور سور پینل متاثر ہونے کا خدشہ۔
