**FIRST HEATWAVE FOR THE MONTH OF MAY – 2025 IS EXPECTED**  
**DURING NEXT THREE TO FOUR DAYS**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure is likely to grip most parts of the country on 15<sup>th</sup> May. Under the influence of this meteorological condition:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C** above normal in Southern half (Sindh) **from 15<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> May.**

**Possible Impacts and advice:**

- Due to heatwave conditions in the province, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.

2. In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/6290 dated: 27-02-2025, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts.

**Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.**

**Heatwave Alert:**

**First heatwave for the month of May-2025 is expected during next three to four days**

Met office predicted that a high pressure is likely to grip most parts of the country on 15<sup>th</sup> May.

Under the influence of this meteorological condition:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain **04 to 06°C above normal in southern half** (Sindh, southern Punjab and Balochistan) **from 15<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> May.**
- Day temperatures are likely to remain **05 to 07°C above normal** in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) **from 15<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> May.**

A westerly weather system is expected to enter upper parts of the country on **19<sup>th</sup> May (evening/night)**. Rain-wind/thunderstorm (isolated heavyfalls/hailstorm) is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Pothohar region including northeast Punjab, upper Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan on **19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup> May.**

**Possible Impacts and advice:**

- **Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.**
- **Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.**
- **Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.**
- **Rising temperatures in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate during the forecast period.**
- **Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.**

**Note:** All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق 15 مئی سے ہوا کا زیادہ دباؤ ملک کے بیشتر علاقوں پر اثر انداز ہوگا۔ جس کے باعث:

- 15 سے 20 مئی کے دوران ملک کے جنوبی علاقوں (سندھ، جنوبی پنجاب اور بلوچستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 04 سے 06 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کا امکان۔
- 15 سے 19 مئی کے دوران ملک کے بالائی علاقوں (وسطی/بالائی پنجاب، اسلام آباد، خیبر پختونخوا، کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان) میں دن کا درجہ حرارت معمول سے 05 سے 07 ڈگری سینٹی گریڈ زیادہ رہنے کی توقع۔

19 مئی (شام/رات) سے مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ ملک کے بالائی علاقوں میں داخل ہونے کی پیش گوئی۔ کشمیر، اسلام آباد، خطہ پوٹھوہار سمیت شمال مشرقی پنجاب، بالائی خیبر پختونخوا اور گلگت بلتستان میں 19/20 مئی سے آندھی/جھکڑ چلنے اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان ہے۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر موسلا دھار بارش/ژالہ باری کی توقع۔

  - شمالی علاقوں میں درجہ حرارت میں اضافہ برف پگھلنے کی شرح کو بڑھا سکتا ہے۔
  - زندگی کے تمام شعبوں میں پانی کے درست استعمال کی ہدایت۔
