

<u>FIRST HEATWAVE FOR THE MONTH OF MAY - 2025 IS EXPECTED</u> DURING NEXT THREE TO FOUR DAYS

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that a high pressure is likely to grip most parts of the country on 15th May. Under the influence of this meteorological condition:

• Day temperatures are likely to remain <u>04 to 06°C</u> above normal in Southern half (Sindh) **from 15th to 20th May.**

Possible Impacts and advice:

- Due to heatwave conditions in the province, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.
- 2. In view of above, the concerned Deputy Commissioner(s)/Chairmen DDMA(s), line departments and other relevant authorities are requested to take necessary precautionary measures in accordance with the Heatwave SOPs already communicated by this Authority vide letter No. PDMA(S)/7/(78)/15/6290 dated: 27-02-2025, besides take all additional remedial measures for reducing Heatwave impacts.

Note: All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.



Heatwave Alert:

Date: 14th May, 2025 Time: 11:00 PST

First heatwave for the month of May-2025 is expected during next three to four days

Met office predicted that a high pressure is likely to grip most parts of the country on 15th May. Under the influence of this meteorological condition:

- Day temperatures are likely to remain <u>04 to 06°C</u> above normal in southern half (Sindh, southern Punjab and Balochistan) from 15th to 20th May.
- Day temperatures are likely to remain <u>05 to 07°C</u> above normal in upper half (central & upper Punjab, Islamabad, Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, Kashmir, Gilgit-Baltistan) from 15th to 19th May.

A westerly weather system is expected to enter upper parts of the country on 19th May (evening/night). Rainwind/thunderstorm (isolated heavyfalls/hailstorm) is expected in Kashmir, Islamabad, Pothohar region including northeast Punjab, upper Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan on 19th/20th May.

Possible Impacts and advice:

- Due to heatwave conditions in the country, general public especially children, women and senior citizens are advised to take precautionary measures.
- Avoid exposure to direct sun light during the day time and remain hydrated.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions and take care of their livestock as well.
- Rising temperatures in northern areas may enhance snowmelt rate during the forecast period.
- Judicious use of water is requested in all fields of life.

<u>Note:</u> All concerned authorities are advised to remain "ALERT" and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation due to heatwave conditions.
