Subject: **PRE-MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN SINDH FROM 22<sup>ND</sup> TO 24<sup>TH</sup> JUNE**

Pakistan Meteorological Department has informed that moist currents from Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea are penetrating upper and central parts of the country and a westerly wave is also likely to approach upper parts on 20<sup>th</sup> June. Under the influence of this weather system:

- Dust storm / rain-wind / thundershower is expected in Sukkur, Larkano, Dadu, and Jacobabad from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> June.

Keeping in view above, it is requested that concerned Deputy Commissioners / Chairman DDMA's and other relevant authorities/ stakeholders may take all necessary mitigation measures.

**Possible Impacts and Advice:**

- Windstorm / dust-thunderstorm / lightning may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles, and solar panels in upper / central parts of the country.
- Very hot weather conditions are likely to subside gradually during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions.
- General Public, Travelers, and Tourists are advised to take precautionary measures during the weather activity.

**Pre-monsoon rains predicted in the country from 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June with occasional gaps**

Met Office informed that moist currents from Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea are penetrating upper and central parts of the country and a westerly wave is also likely to approach upper parts on 20<sup>th</sup> June. Under the influence of this weather system:

- Duststorm/rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavy fall/hailstorm) are expected in Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Haripur, Abbottabad, Mansehra, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Battagram, Shangla, Kohistan, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Nowshera, Charsadda, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Kurram, Kohat, Bannu, Karak, D.I. Khan and Waziristan from 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June with occasional gaps.
- Duststorm/rain-wind/thundershower is expected in Zhob, Barkhan, Musakhel, Kalat, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar and Sahiwal from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June with occasional gaps.
- Duststorm/rain-wind/thundershower is expected in Sukkur, Larkana, Dadu and Jacobabad from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> June.

**Possible Impacts and advice:**

- Windstorm/dust-thunderstorm/lightning may damage loose structures like electric poles, trees, vehicles and solar panels etc in upper/central parts including Islamabad.
- Very hot weather conditions are likely to subside gradually during the forecast period.
- Farmers are advised to manage their crop activities keeping in view the weather conditions.
- General Public, Travelers & Tourists are advised to take precautionary measures during the weather activity.
- Urban flooding may occur in Lahore, Gujranwala, Rawalpindi/Islamabad during the forecast period.

**Note:** All concerned authorities are advised to remain “ALERT” and take necessary measures to avoid any untoward situation.

**20 سے 23 جون کے دوران ملک میں وقفے وقفے سے پری مون سون بارشوں کی پیش گوئی**

محکمہ موسمیات کے مطابق مرطوب ہوائیں خلیج بنگال اور بحیرہ عرب سے ملک کے بالائی/وسطی علاقوں میں داخل ہوں گی اور مغربی ہواؤں کا سلسلہ بھی 20 جون سے ملک کے بالائی علاقوں پر اثر انداز ہونے کا امکان ہے۔ جس کے باعث:

- **20 سے 23 جون کے دوران:** کشمیر، گلگت بلتستان، مری، گلیات، اسلام آباد، راولپنڈی، اٹک، چکوال، جہلم، میانوالی، سرگودھا، حافظ آباد، منڈی بہاؤالدین، گوجرانوالہ، گجرات، سیالکوٹ، نارووال، لاہور، فیصل آباد، جھنگ، ٹوبہ ٹیک سنگھ، ہری پور، ایبٹ آباد، مانسہرہ، چترال، دیر سوات، مالاکنڈ، بٹگرام، شائلنگہ، کوہستان، پشاور، مردان، صوابی، نوشہرہ، چارسدہ، باجوڑ، مہمند، خیبر، اورکزئی، کرم، کوہاٹ، بنوں، کرک، ڈیرہ اسماعیل خان اور وزیرستان میں آندھی/جھکڑ اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کا امکان۔ اس دوران چند مقامات پر تیز بارش/ٹالہ باری کی بھی توقع۔
- **21 سے 23 جون کے دوران:** ڈوب، بارکھان، موسیٰ خیل، قلات، ڈیرہ غازی خان، ملتان، بہاولپور، بہاولنگر اور ساہیوال میں آندھی/جھکڑ اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ وقفے وقفے سے بارش کی توقع۔
- **22 سے 24 جون کے دوران:** سکھر، لاڑکانہ، دادو اور جیکب آباد میں آندھی/جھکڑ چلنے اور گرج چمک کے ساتھ بارش کا امکان۔

**ملکنہ اثرات اور احتیاطی تدابیر:**

- اسلام آباد سمیت بالائی/وسطی حصوں میں آندھی/جھکڑ/گرج چمک اور تیز موسلا دھار بارش کے باعث کمزور انفراسٹرکچر (بجلی کے کھمبے، درخت، گاڑیوں، سولر پینل وغیرہ) کو نقصان کا اندیشہ۔
- اس دوران موجودہ شدید گرمی میں کمی کا امکان۔
- کاشت کار حضرات اپنی فصلوں کے معاملات موسمی حالات کے مطابق ترتیب دیں۔
- عوام الناس مسافروں اور سیاحوں کو خراب موسم کے دوران احتیاطی تدابیر اختیار کرنے کا مشورہ۔
- اس دوران لاہور، گوجرانوالہ، راولپنڈی/اسلام آباد میں اربن فلڈنگ کا خدشہ۔
- **نوٹ:** تمام متعلقہ اداروں کو اس دوران ”ارٹ“ رہنے اور کسی ناخوشگوار واقعہ سے بچنے کے لیے تمام ضروری اقدامات کرنے کی ہدایت کی جاتی ہے۔
